## **Dick Garvey Annual IPA Competition**

### 2012 Second Annual Edition

This year's competition will take place once again at Pat's house on Saturday, one September, 2012 at twelve noon. The beer style, as called by last year's winner, is to be an American IPA. This beer is clearly defined in the BJCP Style Guidelines. The winner may be asked to show the recipe and if the guidelines are found to be amiss the offender may be subject to a dog piling as directed by the Sergeant at Arms.

The entry fee shall be the same as last year, seven dollars and twenty seven cents.

Please submit your entry to the receiving officer at Pat's house in one of the following three forms:

- One, a sixty four ounce growler
- Two, three twenty two ounce bomber bottles, or
- Three, six twelve ounce bottles

This is a popularity contest and the scoring will be as follows:

Only paid members of the BREW club will be allowed to vote.

If any non member wishes to vote they may state their case to the paid members and may be granted temporary membership status, gratis.

Open public discussion of the merits or demerits of each sample is encouraged.

The first criteria on the scorecard will be the question "Do you feel that the sample meets the requirements of an American IPA?" The score will be one point for a yes and zero points for a no. Any BJCP judge with credentials may award up to five points.

The second and last criteria on the scorecard will be the question "How does this sample rank as to your personal favorite?" The score will be from zero up to a maximum of the amount of entries we receive. For example, last year we had fourteen entries and the maximum score in that case would be fourteen. Again, anyone with BJCP credentials may award an extra four points.

At the proceeding awards ceremony, the high score winner will take all the money, wear the crown of hops, and receive the coveted trophy.
